# Oil Line Laid From State Wells

Kerr-McGee Petroleum Corp. is laying a pipeline from its new oil wells in Northeast Arizona to the Four Corners pipeline near Shiprock, N. M.

The 35-mile hookup will enable the firm to increase its Arizona production. The Four Corners pipeline carries crude oil to West Coast markets.

Kerr-McGee has five producing wells near Red Rock in Apache County. Humble Oil & Refining Co. has at least one producing well at the site.

The area is expected to be the scene of increased exploration following a recent auction by the Navajo Indians at which vast tracts were leased to major oil companies and independents.
